# Itinerary

## SAT-JUL 17<sup>th</sup> - TORONTO/WARSAW

Departure from Buffalo to Toronto International Airport for direct flight to Warsaw.

## SAT-JUL 18<sup>th</sup> WARSAW/KRAKOW

Arrival transfer to your hotel. In & evening dinner at fashionable Decius Villa. After dinner walking tour of Old Town. (D)

## MON-JULY 19<sup>th</sup> -KRAKOW/WIELICZKA

After breakfast city tour of Krakow including Wawel Castle, St. Mary's Church., Old Town. In the afternoon excursion to Wieliczka Salt Mine. A legendary ghost will show up to tell a "about the salt mine and will give out a sack of salt to everyone. In the evening dinner with entertainment. (BP)

## TUE-JULY 20<sup>th</sup> - KRAKOW/RZESZOW

In the morning we take you to Buffalo's sister city of Rzeszow and Lancut, a 17<sup>th</sup> century palace complex. Back to Krakow for overnight. (B,D)

## WED - JULY 21<sup>st</sup> - KRAKOW/ZAKOPANE

This morning we take you to Zakopane, a resort high in the Tatra Mountain. You will visit typical highlanders and see their arts and handicrafts for which the area has become famous. In the evening dinner with folklore entertainment (B,D)

## THU-JULY 22-ZAKOPANE

After breakfast we take a cable car to Gubalowka to see panoramic view of Zakopane. We also visit Morskie Oko, the largest lake in the Tatras. We spend some time shopping at the traffic-free, pedestrian shops. In the evening dinner at "Chata Zbojnicka" with highlanders music. (B,D)

## FRI-JULY 23<sup>rd</sup> ZAKOPANE/WROCLAW

On the way to Wroclaw, we stop in **Czestochowa**, site of Jasna Gora Monastery, home to "Black Madonna". (B,D)

## SAT-JULY 24<sup>th</sup> -WROCLAW.

In the morning city tour of Wroclaw, which includes medieval architecture and 13<sup>th</sup> century Town Hall and "Panorama Raclawicka", painting depicting the victorious battle of 1794. (BD)

## SUN-JULY 25<sup>th</sup> -WROCLAW/POZNAN

On the way from Wroclaw to Poznan, we stop at **Lichen**, the second most famous sanctuary devoted to the cult of the Virgin Mary and the largest church in Poland. (BP)

## MON - JULY 26<sup>th</sup> -POZNAN/TORUN/GDANSK

This morning after tour of Poznan's Old Town we head to Torun, the medieval town so closely associated with Copernicus. On the way, we stop to see the Cathedral in Gniezno. (B,D)

## TUE-JULY 27<sup>th</sup> -GDANSK

We devote this day to the tri-city complex of Gdansk, Gdynia and Sopot. Say "Gdansk" and the first image that comes to mind is the birthplace of Solidarity Movement. A stop is made at the "Path to Freedom", an exhibit commemorating Solidarity and its fight for liberation from the barriers from Communism (BP)

## WED-JULY 28<sup>th</sup> -GDANSK/WARSAW

On the way to Warsaw, we make a stop in **Malbork**, a mighty stone fortress, it once housed an Order of Teutonic Knights. (BD)

## THU-JULY 29<sup>th</sup> -WARSAW

Today, see Warsaw through our eyes: Old Town, the Ghetto Memorial, the Popieluszko and Chopin monuments. In the afternoon we take you to Zelazowa Wola, where Chopin was born. In evening you are invited for a farewell dinner (BD)

## FRI-JULY 30<sup>th</sup> -WARSAW/TORONTO

After breakfast you will visit Wilanow (King Sobieski Residence). Early afternoon you will be transferred to the airport for flight back to Toronto and return bus transportation to Buffalo.
